***Winnebago County Health Department to Hold a Tire Recycling Drive for
Winnebago County Home Owners on Saturday, March 25, 2017***

On Saturday, March 25, 2017 the Environmental Health Center of the Winnebago County Health Department is planning on holding a Tire Drive for County residents to be able to drop off up to 24 passenger vehicle-sized tires per household. The goal of the event is to allow home owners to turn in used tires at no cost.

Participants must register in advance by completing an on-line application available at the Winnebago County Health Department website. Confirmation of registration will be sent to each approved household via postcard. This postcard will serve as an admission ticket to the event and will indicate the location of the drop-off site within the City of Rockford.

Individuals must be Winnebago County residents to participate, and registration will be limited to one application per household. Registration will close at 5:00 pm on Friday, March 17, 2017, or earlier, if applications exceed the allowable limit of participants and number of tires. Tires must be de-rimmed and from passenger vehicles and light trucks only (i.e. no tractor tires).
