

Are you in need of assistance with applying for Health Care Coverage as part of the Affordable Care Act (ACA)?

Here are a few questions you need to answer to determine what steps to take next.

1) Do you currently have Health Care Coverage through work, a spouse or a parent?

- **If YES:** There is nothing else you will need to do unless your coverage will end, or you are currently pregnant. **If your coverage will end:** you can apply online at www.GetCoveredIllinois.gov call 866-311-1119 to apply, or make an appointment with one of the In-Person Counselors to apply in person. You will need to provide some specific documentation and information at your appointment. **If you are pregnant:** go to question 3.
- **If NO:** You can apply online at www.GetCoveredIllinois.gov or call 866-311-1119 to apply by phone. On the other hand, you can make an appointment with one of the In-Person Counselors/Navigators to apply in person. You will need to provide some specific documentation and information at your appointment.

2) Do you or anyone else in your family already have an Illinois Medical Card? (Family meaning a spouse, child)

- **If YES:** You will need to contact your caseworker at the local DHS Office.
- **If NO:** You can apply online at www.GetCoveredIllinois.gov, call 866-311-1119 to apply, or you can make an appointment with one of the In-Person Counselors to apply in person. You will need to provide some specific documentation and information at your appointment.

3) If Pregnant- Does your Insurance cover Maternity Care?

- **If YES:** There is nothing else you need to do.
- **If NO:** You will need to make an appointment with one of the In-Person Counselors at Winnebago County Health Department to apply. You will need to provide some specific documentation and information at your appointment. If you have Health Care Coverage, but it does not cover Maternity Care, or it will be ending: You will need to provide your current Insurance Card with Policy number, group number, and the policy start and end dates.

HAVE QUESTIONS or NEED AN APPOINTMENT?

Please contact one of the trained and licensed In-Person Counselors listed.

Documentation & Information needed at Appointment:

- **Full Name and Date of Birth** of everyone currently living in the home.
- **Proof of ALL income** for the last 30 days for everyone living in the home.
- **Social Security Cards** for everyone applying for benefits.
- **Proof of Identity** for everyone applying for benefits.
- **Proof of ILLINOIS Residence** - Must have correct & current address.
- **Provide proof of household expenses** such as rent receipt, mortgage payment book, all utilities you pay, and most recent bank statement for each account.
